Leadership in Ethnically Diverse Communities

To develop the leadership capacity in ethnically diverse communities for the purpose of building intentional inclusion.

Who is the program for? The program is designed for community members who are committed to working across cultural differences to create a more inclusive community.

About the program Participants will:

- Have a deeper understanding of culture and its role in building relationships.
- Examine specific cultural differences of conflict interaction styles and their impact.
- Work in partnership with other participants to build and strengthen relationships.
- Develop plans to expand their engagement in the community in ways that promote inclusion and build on their work as a group.

What is my commitment? The program is four sessions spread out over two months. All program sessions will be held in the community, and each participant is asked to commit to all four sessions.

What is the cost? The Blandin Foundation covers the cost of tuition, meals, and training. The cost to participants is their time and travel to and from each session. If attendance at the program creates a financial hardship, enabling funds are available.
